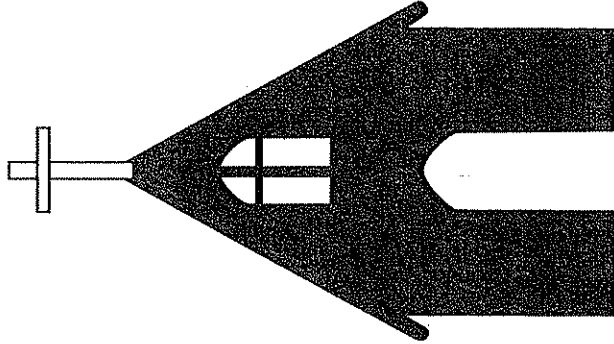

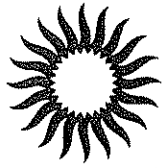

Facilities

The Summer Youth Program is housed in Fifth Baptist Church, located at 1415 West Cary Street near downtown Richmond. In addition to a beautiful sanctuary, the church is fully air conditioned with various classrooms, a dining area with a modern kitchen and a gymnasium.



Enrollment & Fees

Enrollment is necessarily limited to ensure a good teacher-student ratio. It is important that your application be returned as soon as possible. First consideration will be given to those who sign up for the entire ten weeks. Your application must be accompanied by a \$5.00 non-refundable fee.

The weekly fee will be \$70.00 a week, which includes the trips. Two siblings would be \$130.00 per week. **Make all checks payable to FBC Summer Youth Program.**

Breakfast is provided for all children. **Children need to bring their own moderate lunch in a sack or lunch box daily and an afternoon snack.**
